

Beginning Cabochon Class Check List

SUPPLIES:

TLS will provide all of the materials you will need for the workshop including a variety of slabs of different types of rough material suitable for making cabochons. If you have any slabs of stone that you would like to form into a cabochon, please bring them as well. We are also always happy to check out any interesting stones, slabbed or not, that you would like to show to bring to class.

DRESS:

Please dress comfortably in clothes that can withstand soiling. The saws are cooled with oil and the other equipment with water. It can get sloppy at times! Please avoid loose long sleeves. Long hair must be tied back for safety.

SUGGESTED EQUIPMENT:

1. Bring a full length fabric or vinyl work apron if you have one. If you don't have one, that's fine. We will supply you with a plastic apron.
2. If you have safety glasses, please bring them. We will supply safety glasses when you need them if you don't have a pair.
3. Bring an old hand towel if you have one.
4. Bring an Ultra Fine Point Sharpie.
5. Bring a pen or pencil and some note paper, and a small box or sandwich bag to carry home your stones.
6. Bring a loupe or magnifying glass, if already own one. If you don't have one, that's fine. Course notes with illustrations will be provided at class.
