TITLE: INTRO TO BEZEL SETTING - RING, WITH KIEU PHAM GRAY

Description: Have you been collecting rocks? Is it time to bring them out of the box to show them off? Take this class to learn how to put some glam into your bling. In this introductory bezel setting class, you'll learn to create a custom ring from start to finish. Using sterling silver, you'll shape, solder, and form a ring band, then craft a bezel to securely set a cabochon stone. Along the way, you'll gain hands-on experience with essential metalsmithing techniques like sawing, filing, soldering, and stone setting—perfect for beginning stone setters to turn their favorite stones into wearable art.
