

## **Boro Chain-making - Guest Instructor Jeri Warhaftig**

This workshop is for those with some glass flameworking experience.

This is a one-day workshop, June 28, 2026. We will start at 9AM. **Please arrive no later than 8:45AM so that we may start on time.** The class will be held at the Tuscarora Lapidary Society's Education Center at 24 Upland Road, Brookhaven, PA 19015.

If you have glass beadmaking tools such as patterned mashers such as leaf, spiral, or herringbone, please bring them. Bring your own suitable eye protection, which should be didymium glasses or stronger, if you have it. We have all the tools you will need, but there are some tools that Jeri likes to use for chain making that we do not have. These include:

**Brass Poker**, the type carried by these makers:

if you don't have one of these tools, we have graphite rods that can be used in their place.

**Tungsten tweezers**

If you don't already have them, Jeri prefers the small bent angle version,
