

## Enameling Supply List

- Sable or synthetic sable brush. Brush size 00. (Can also use 000 for finer detail)

(Kolinsky Sable miniature paint brush works well and is available on Amazon)

- Graphite pencil. Regular graphite pencil will work, but darker graphite is better.
- Copper shapes and decals will be available for purchase in class, but you may purchase your own if you have metal shapes or decal designs you would like.

### **If you choose to purchase your own:**

- Copper gauge should be between 20-26. Metal gets heavier when you add glass so for earrings you want 24-26 gauge. Pieces made for brooches or pendants can be a heavier gauge if you choose, but do not have to be.
- Rio Grande sells sheets of copper if you want to cut your own shapes.
- Pre-cut copper shapes can be purchased at many places, including Rio Grande, Cool Tools, Etsy, e-namels.com, and Pearly's Supply (largest selection).
- For decals, you want to make sure they are waterslide ceramic decals for enameling.
- Places to purchase decals include Cool Tools, Pearly's Supply, Etsy, vintage decals can be found on eBay (just be sure they are waterslide ceramic decals for enameling).

\* Note some decals work better than others. I will be bringing in a variety of decals to use.

- I will have sterling silver ear wire available for purchase, but you may choose to purchase your own sterling silver or stainless steel ear wire.
